In addition, they will work with UCL green champions to improve UCL environmentally. This is a part-time role.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Chair the Ethics and Environment Forum, and sit on the UCLU Finance committee
- Be an active member of Union Council and other committees
- Assist in environment accreditations such as NUS Green Impact Award
- Help organise and promote Fair Trade Fortnight
